Rules of the Game:

Goal	The team who correctly orders themselves first, wins
Rules	Divide the players into 2 groups
	Each player can only be told their number once
Steps	Step 1: On pieces of paper the size of your palm, write two groups of
	consecutive numbers below 20 (the number of papers should equal the number
	of players in each group)
	Step 2: Using tape, paste the pieces of paper onto each player's back (the
	players should not be aware of their own number)
	Step 3: The players read out loud each other's' number once within their group
	Store A. Boood on the government in the group the allowance headed
	Step 4: Based on the numbers in the group, the players should order
	themselves in numerical order
	Step 5: The first group to correctly order themselves, wins

Variations of the	Instead of consecutive numbers, the players can be given numbers that skip 2
Game	or 3. So they would have to order themselves in multiples of 2 or 3
	Instead of ascending order, the players are required to order themselves in descending order



	The number range can be increased from 1-50
Enrichment	For some geometry practice, ask students to organize along a line or along
	different shapes
Simplification	If the player needs to be told their number more than once, other players are
	allowed to remind them
	Instead of 1-20 the range can be 1-10
